To build a stronger, healthier, more compassionate community in San Luis Obispo County by focusing on education, income, and health.



## Qualifications and Requirements

High school students of SLO County are eligible to apply. The Youth Board holds meetings on the 1st and 3rd Monday evening of each month, from October until May. Members are allowed to miss up to three meetings, however, attendance is necessary for the group to function at its highest level and students are encouraged to participate in discussions, voice their opinions, share ideas, and offer input. United Way hosts several fundraising and community service events per year, and members are expected to volunteer for at least one of these events per semester.
